Sapphire



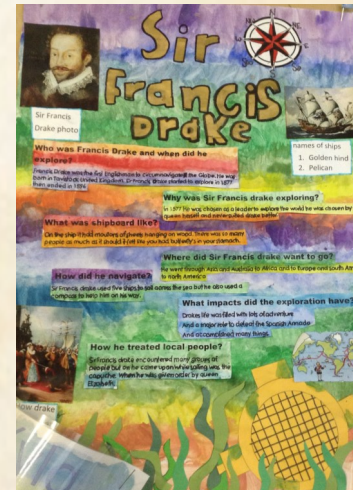

They learnt about significant individuals of the Age of Exploration (circa 1400–1800) and closely examined the journey of one explorer. They developed skills of historical inquiry; learning to pose research questions, locate and analyse information, communicate their findings to others, and reflect upon and evaluate what they learnt.
